A Collaborative Approach to Supervising Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, & Social Workers in Private Practice, University and Clinic Settings*

Purpose: The course provides *a collaborative forum for both experienced and new supervisors* to develop and enhance their supervision competencies. It is designed to meet the requirements for those seeking qualification as supervisors for Licensed Professional Counselors, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists, Social Workers and American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) Approved Supervisor status. The course may be used for continuing education hours.

Focus: The course focuses on *practical, theoretical, legal, ethical, relationship, and personal and professional development issues* in supervision. There is an emphasis on supervision from a postmodern collaborative perspective--drawing on the metaphors of social construction and narrative--within the broader context and history of systemic theories.

Format: *A dynamic and intensive didactic and interactive experience based in a collaborative learning community philosophy* will provide participants opportunities to place philosophical assumptions and theory into practice, to network with other supervisors, and to develop and expand their supervision skills. Format will include didactic, consultation, observation of supervision, reflecting processes, experiential exercises, literature review, reflection papers for each meeting, and on-line opportunities with other supervisors.

Criteria for Certificate of Completion:

- Philosophy of supervision essay.
- At-home reading/learning assignments
- Observations of individual and group supervision.
- Reflection paper for each observation.
- Reflection paper for each seminar meeting day.
- Supervision case study and analysis.
- Student supervisor self-evaluation form.
- Student supervisor program/faculty evaluation form.

Certificate of Completion: A certificate of completion will be provided by the Houston Galveston Institute.

Who Should Attend: This seminar is appropriate for professionals seeking board approved Supervisor status.

Time Requirements: Course certificate requires attendance at two (2), two-day meetings, participation in online learning, and observation of supervision. Provides 40 course or continuing education hours; course includes a minimum of 16 hours of didactic and 16 hours of interactional learning. In addition, the course requires completion of 8 hours of independent and on-line learning assignments outside the classroom which includes observation of supervision, at-home reading, reflection papers and personal philosophy of supervision paper.
